We draw upon Proverbs 22:6 to guide us as a team...

*“Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old he will not depart from it.”*

There are two parts to this verse which identify our role as a VK leader. Firstly, *“the way he should go”* indicates both a direction and a connection. Throughout our Victory Kids activities, we encourage children to connect with God, others and their unique purpose. Secondly, *“train up a child”* indicates an equipping of knowledge, skills and understanding. Our Victory Kids teams aim to encourage children to recognise their God-given gifts and talents, to develop the skills required to fulfill their purpose, and to help the children recognize opportunities to significantly impact the lives of others for God.

### Steps to Joining our VK Team

#### 1. Ask Questions

Sometimes there are gaps in the decision-process. Try to identify these gaps and ask questions of a variety of people – VK pastor and leaders, your connect group leaders, your friends/family, and/or your mentor. They will know different aspects of you, both your past and your potential, and be able to give you advice. Be careful that you are consulting the advice of people who will tell you what you need to hear and not what you want to hear!

#### 2. Pray

Ask God for guidance with your decision. Sometimes God will speak loudly to you through a variety of ways and people, and other times we just need to step out in faith and be available where there are needs. When you pray to God, ask for the three C's: clarity, confirmation and courage!

#### 3. Contact Us

Make a time to chat with us (Mick and Katie Roberts) and discuss your

interest and our expectations. We will provide you with an application for a National Police Criminal History Clearance, and provide you with details regarding Child-Safe Environments training. You will need to complete components VC101, VC 201 and VC 301 to be considered. For more information, see the FAMILY Discipleship Program page on our main website. As part of the process, we will also identify you as a potential team member in an email to Victory Church Pastors, who will provide a response. Upon approval, you will be provided with orientation, and introduced to the appropriate Coordinators and team leaders. We have a four-week trial period, after which your team leader and Coordinator will meet with you to discuss how things have been going.
